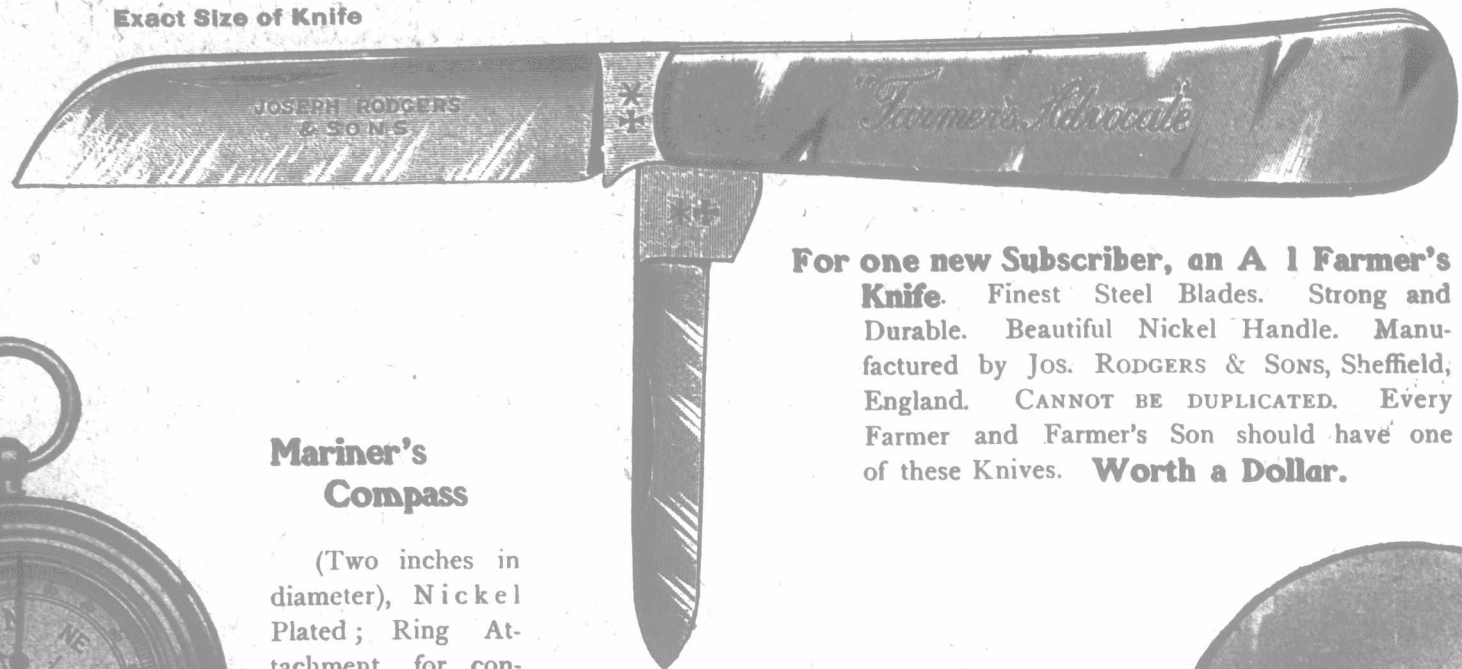

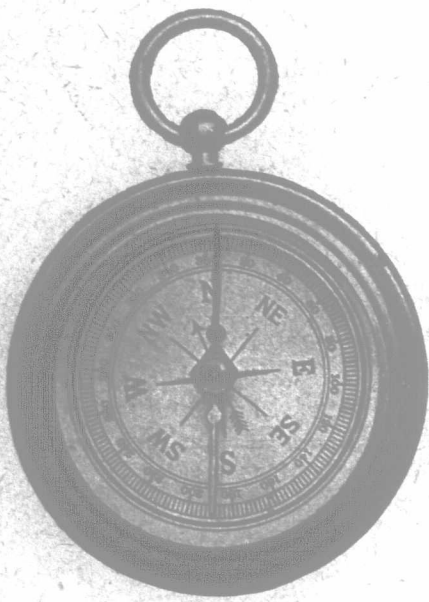

Exact Size of Knife

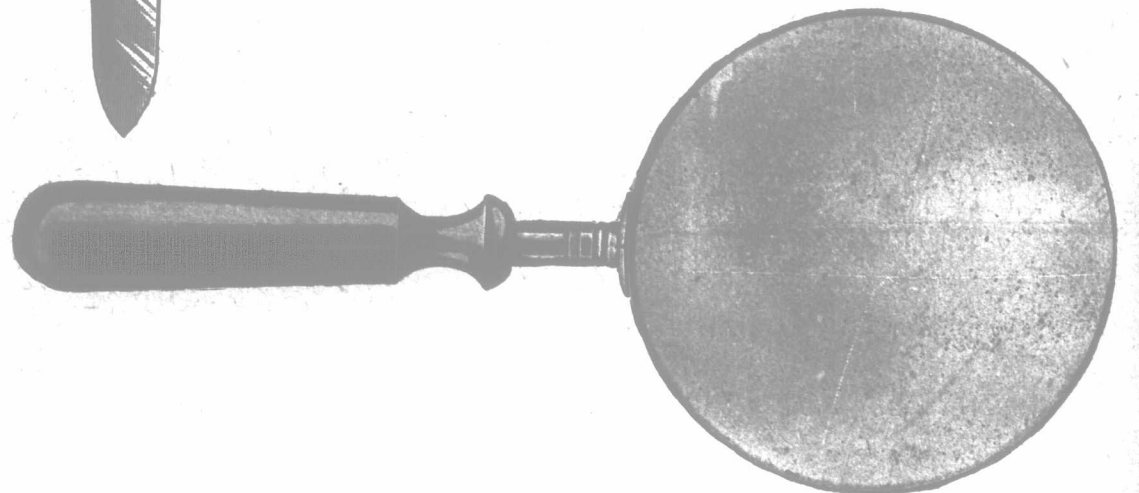

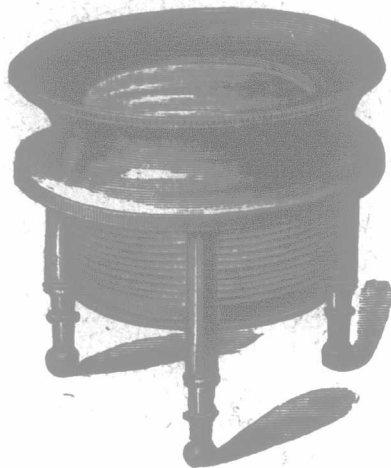

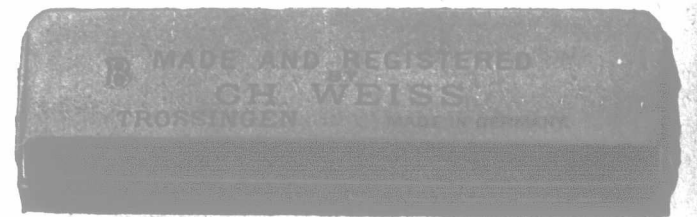
