NEWS OF NORFOLK

Funeral of Capt. H. Paulin Very Largely Attended. ALL MILITARY HONORS. Tendered Remains of One Who Died for Country. OTHER SIMCOE NEWS. Daughters of Empire Plan Paper Collection.

Simcoe, April 17.—Norfolk had paid her last tribute to all that is mortal of Capt. A. H. Paulin. The rifles have discharged the three volleys over his prostrate form and the bugles have sounded the dirge.

It was a Large Funeral. In the north ward to Oakwood, quite over a mile, crowded in mass along the streets or moved slowly, keeping time with the procession, and on reaching the open grave, forgetful of the dead underneath, their feet and considering moments nothing more than places of vantage, the mass of humanity closed in so close that the last rites were performed with difficulty.

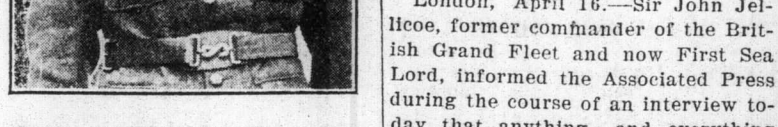

USE SMALL CRAFT TO FIGHT U-BOAT

Sir John Jellicoe Indicates Best Naval Contribution From U. S. AGAINST ENEMY SUBS. Everything From Destroyers to Tugs of Value.



London, April 16.—Sir John Jellicoe, former commander of the British Grand Fleet and now First Sea Lord, informed the Associated Press during the course of an interview today that anything and everything in the way of small craft, from destroyers to tugs, would be the most useful contribution which the United States could make to the war against submarines.

Must Give Tonnage. "As far as the feeding of the allied populations is concerned, our efforts must be directed to securing supplies, while bringing in the necessary supplies in order to minimize the effect of the submarine warfare. As you probably know, we have bought large quantities of wheat in Australia, but as the round voyage takes four times as long as that to America the bringing of wheat takes four times as long as that to America carrying of American wheat to the allied powers. We therefore require all the wheat we can obtain from the United States and Canada."

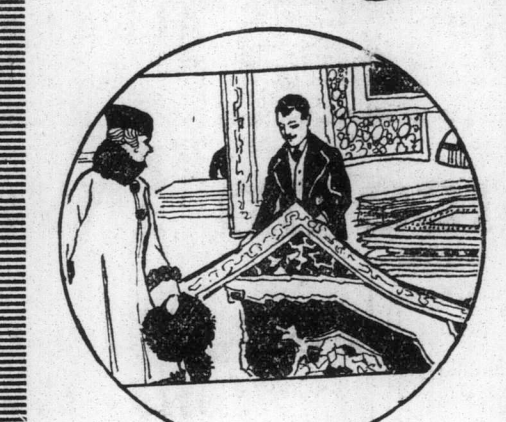

MUNICIPAL BOARD HERE

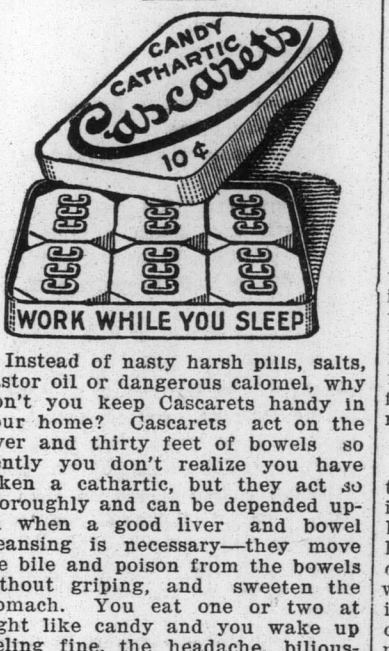
Sitting of Provincial Body Held in Court House This Morning. TWO CASES HEARD. Concerning Norfolk County Telephone Co.
