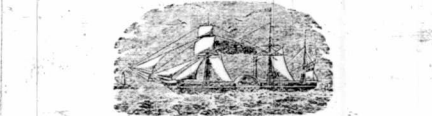
SUMMARY OF THE WEEK'S NEWS.
