

Cop inhagen, April 17._German govnment troops occupied the entire own of Madgeburg Tuesday, according to a Weimer dispatch to the Local Anzeiger of Berlin. It is reported there was hard fighting with many casualties on both sides.

Berlin, April 17._The Battle in Munch for the central railway station ended in the domplete defeat of the government trops, according to Nuremberg advices.

Munich again is completely in the ands of the Communists, according to the Tageblatt, but troops loyal to the government have received reinorcements and are using artillery against the Communist stronghold in he Central Railway station.

Street fighting in the Bavarian captal is increasing. Many civilians have been killed or wounded.

Reinforcements for the loyal troops are being hurried to Munich from varous parts of Bavaria.

The Communist force in Munich, the newspaper adds, consists of parts of the garrison, red guards and unemploy ed. The Governmena forces are de clared to be having a hard batle with

THhe Government has declined to force a food blockade against Munch, owing to the distress it would cause in the city.

Paris, April 17._Direct news from Bavaria is still lacking in peace conference circles. The overnight davelopments reported in the press, however, caused less confidence to be falt than previously that the Scheidmann gov ernment would be able to control the

An American mission comprising Messrs. Ellis, Gresel, Lithgow and Osborna, with a force of clerks, will leave for Berlin for the purpose of keeping the American peace delegation inform ed of events.
