James Whitcomb Riley, of whom Mary E. Wilkins Freeman said: "One might as well try to make a home attractive without flowers as without the grace of James Whitcomb Riley's verses."

Of whom Booth Tarkington said: "He was the first and the foremost distinctly American poet and at the time of his death he was the greatest American."

An' they walked with him the pathways that they knew when they were boys.

But the Heavenly angel missed him, missed his tender, gentle knack Of making people happy, an' they wanted Riley back.
