1st of the Colonial Sec'y, October 30th, 1918.

On and after this date the retail price of white granulated sugar within the Municipal limits of the town of St. John's shall not exceed 14 cents per pound, and in the outports 15 cents per pound.

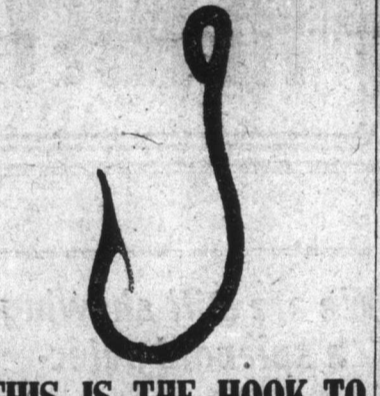

MANUEL'S ISLAND-Catalina Harbor LIGHT ESTABLISHED.

Latitude 48. 30. 40. N. Longitude 53. 03. 40. W.

Notice is hereby given, that a Round Iron Tower, painted White, has been erected on Manuel's Island, Catalina Harbor, from which will be exhibited a Fixed Red Light.

Height from sea level to base of tower 7 feet.

Height from base to centre of light 13 1/2 feet.

This light is established for the purpose of indicating the Island and Shoal projecting from its Southern side, and is obscured in line with the Charlton Rock on the North side of entrance to Harbor.

Charlton Rock in line with Burnt Point and the Light Tower on Green Island bearing S. by E. and the Light Tower on Manuel's Island bearing W.N.W. from rock indicates its position.
