Toronto, March 9.—Wheat is not offering freely; demand for red and white steady at 64 1/2 to 65 for red and white west. Goose wheat unchanged at 68c low freight wheat. Spring wheat is steady at 65c east. Manitoba wheat is quoted at 80 1/2 to 81c for No. 1 hard grinding in transit, Sarnia; 69c alfalfa. Port William, May, and 79c, North Bay. Flour is quiet; cases of straight roller in barrels are quoted at \$2 30 to \$2 35 west. Millfeed is steady at \$15 to \$18 for shorts, and \$15 for bran west. Barley steady; No. 2, 4 1/2 to 4 3/4 west. Buckwheat quiet at 48c west. Rye is steady at 50 1/2 to 51c steady at 35 1/2 for Canada yellow west. American corn is quoted at 42c for old No. 3 yellow, and 42c for new No. 3, Toronto. Oats steady; mixed, 26 1/2 to 27c; white, 26 1/2 to 27c. Peas dull at 61c to 62c west. Butter receipts moderate; active demand; market firm; dairy pound 20c, 23c to 24c, and large rolls, 22c to 23c; creamery firmer at 24c to 25c for tubs and 26c to 27c for rolls. Eggs—Receipts large; new laid, 15 1/2 to 16c; held fresh at 11c and limed at 12c. Dressed hogs—No offerings; local packers quote \$6 50 to \$6 75 for mixed weights in car lots on track here. Live hogs—Receipts, 1,100; prices steady and unchanged; choice bacon, 5 1/2c; heavy and fat, 5 1/4c.
