Scott Act Administration.

The Scott Act and its administration, is exciting much interest in various towns of the Province at the present moment, but in St. Stephen, the contest between the friends and foes of that measure grows the warmest. On the 6th inst., at a meeting of the Town Council, a resolution authorizing the expenditure of town funds, and instructing the police officers to look up and prosecute offenders, was passed, the authority for the Council's action being based on a written opinion submitted by Mr. G. S. Grimmer, Q. C. A few evenings later the liquor dealers and their supporters met and took issue with the Council, after consultation with Mr. M. McMonaghy, Barrister, passing a resolution calling upon the Council to rescind its resolution and threatening in case of refusal to place an injunction on the town authorities, and to take steps to quash the town assessment. There is therefore now the prospect of a square fight, and the public will look on with interest to its result.

In other provincial towns matters in connection with the Act are not assumed and belligerent shape, and in some of the liquor appears almost unresisted, without the inactivity of the temperance party, or other cause, we know not.

At Woodstock where the Council undertook the prosecution of offenders, and succeeded in getting a good many fines, and having seized points settled in the Courts to the satisfaction of the upholders of the law, action has been abandoned, and in the meantime there is abundance of liquor to be had. Visitors to that town on the 24th of May remarked that more drunkenness was to be seen than in St. John on Centennial day, when in addition to the city's population, nearly ten thousand strangers were present.

At Moncton says "The Times," "the situation has not improved and although an intimation was given at a public meeting two weeks ago that another attempt would be made to enforce the Act, it hangs fire, the bar-rooms are in full blast and there is not the slightest attempt at action. Some have thought that the Council were to be taken for the Milltown decision have re-opened again. The activity of the liquor dealers, and the inactivity of the opponents of the liquor traffic, in most places, are in strong contrast.

Here in Fredericton, which is credited with having a more healthy temperance movement than any other town in the Province, there is an almost complete enforcement of the law, and the open sale of liquor is restricted, but it cannot be denied that it is obtainable in many places, nor will it be denied that whatever success attends the administration of the Act, is more largely due to the Police Magistrate and his efficient officers, than to the temperance people themselves, and in this connection we may add, that to the vigilance of the present police force, is due our comparative immunity from crime of all kinds, a tribute to their activity, which in justice we are glad to be able for ourselves and the community to express. In the administration of the Scott Act, however, they do not receive the support from the temperance party they have a right to expect, and the statement of the "Times," that the activity of the liquor dealers and the inactivity of the opponents of the liquor traffic are in strong contrast," while not as applicable in its complete sense to Fredericton as to Moncton, fairly puts the position of parties in this city.

The conviction of Dr. Gallagher and his associates of being implicated in the dynamite conspiracy is another warning to those friends of Ireland who indulge in the wild dream of helping her by assassination. **A Terrible Slaughter.**

The groans of the killed in the Brooklyn Bridge disaster have scarcely subsided, when the horrible news reaches this city of the water, of the slaughter of twenty-two hundred children, Saturday night, in a public hall at Sunderland, in the County of Durham, England, before which the former, heartrending scene, was pale into insignificance.

From the cable despatches, it appears that the gallery of the hall was filled with twelve hundred children, ranging from four to fourteen years of age, in attendance upon the entertainment of a conjurer; that at the close of the performance the people in the pit were allowed to leave the hall first, and that the entrance to the gallery was closed to a width of twenty inches, so that only one child might be permitted to pass out at once, while the others were crowded together, and the result was a great number were pushed down, trampled upon and suffocated. The scene was terrible and no effort could stop the mad rush of the terrified children, and the result was a great number of them were trampled down and suffocated by others tramping upon them. The greater number of the bodies which were badly mangled from the trampling laid 7 or 8 deep. Many of the victims, and others who were not killed, had the clothing torn from their bodies, and the result was a terrible scene of blood and gore, and the result was a great number of them were trampled down and suffocated by others tramping upon them.

Both the audience and the officials who were in the hall at the time of the disaster, were unaware for some considerable time of the terrible tragedy being enacted at the door. They were not informed until the half-keeper, who straggled near the scene of the calamity, was attracted by the groans, gave the alarm. The man, who gave the alarm, was busy packing up his apparatus to depart, when a man rushed up to him and informed of the disaster, and immediately fell down speechless in a fit. Some of the families whose homes were so suddenly darkened, lost over three children. One man and wife pushed their way into the hall in which lay the bodies of the victims, and without betraying any emotion, began to search the faces of the dead. Recognizing the face of one of his children, the father, who was a fisherman, exclaimed, "That's one," passing on again he recognized another, and then a third. Staggering in a fit of agonized grief, "My God, all my family gone," and overwhelmed with grief, he rushed to the door. In some houses there are five children dead, and one Sunday School loses thirty scholars by the catastrophe. Many of the survivors had their arms broken in the crush, and others are suffering from broken ribs or rupture of internal organs. The scene inside the hall during the identification of the bodies, and the faces of the dead children, in almost every case, were evidence of the suffering, from which many died. Their lips were parched and noses bleeding. Parents making wildly about, would fall upon the bodies of their dead children, weeping and wailing, clasp their unconscious forms in their arms and vainly endeavoring to note some sign of life. Many poor mothers swooned away at the sight of the dead, while others were wild and almost violent in their hysterical grief. Queen Victoria sent a telegram to the Mayor of Sunderland, expressing her grief at the occurrence of the disaster. The children of various Sunday schools also sent telegrams, and flags in London were at half mast.

**Chief Kerr of the Portland City Council.**

Visitors to the recent Centennial Celebration at St. John, will remember a disagreeable misunderstanding, which arose between Chief Engineer Kerr, and certain dignitaries of Portland, but which most people thought had been amicably arranged by the humble and many apology Chief Kerr published in the newspapers the same evening. A very little could be learned of the facts from the St. John press, beyond the mystifying statement in Chief Kerr's apology, but the Portland City Council the other night supplied the sequel in the shape of a silly and pretentious resolution, which has brought out the full facts in the Halifax Mail, whose representative, we believe, was on the spot. It says:—

"Some time previous to the celebration Chief Kerr hired a team for the use of the Halifax Board of Firewardens on the day and night of the procession. During the day they had been driven around in the team, and on the driver leaving them at their hotel in the evening, they instructed the driver to take them at 8.30. This he did not do, and so they could procure no other conveyance, they were obliged to wait where the torchlight procession was to start from. A complaint was made to Chief Kerr, and just at that time the carriage drove up, and in it were seated the four Portland gentlemen. Kerr went at once to the carriage and explained to those seated therein, the circumstances of his having been instructed to take them at 8.30, and politely requested them to give it up, at the same time stating that the gentleman for whom it was hired were strangers in St. John and entitled to some courtesy from those whom they were visiting. The Portland gentlemen, however, refused to leave the carriage, and the Chief had the horses taken from it, at the same time remarking that he would not allow 'any civility of his or of the City of St. John, to be insulted in such a manner.' After a long delay another carriage was procured, and a 'swoop' of horses effected, and the procession finally started. The Portland department, however, broke from the procession shortly after the route of march had been determined and proceeded to their homes. In view of these facts, the action of the Town Council of Portland, appears very unreasonable.
