
POPULATION 110,000.

Winnipeg Is Annoyed Over Recent Census Bulletin.

Winnipeg, Man., Aug. 3 — Assessment Commissioner Harris vigorously assailed the estimate of Winnipeg's population given in the first bulletin issued from Ottawa, which fixes the population at 90,216. Mr. Harris considers the work as done was a farce, and decleares that the pop-ulation is nearer 115,000, and certainly not less than 110,000. Mr. Harris points out that the census was taken at the worst time of the year, when hundreds of people are away at summer re-sorts and their honses are actually closed up, so that it is impossible for enumerators to cover the work efficiently.
