



HUCKLEBERRY CAKE. - One cup of sugar, a piece of butter the size of an egg; beat together until light; then add two eggs and beat again; two-thirds of a cup of milk, two cups of flour, in which have been sifted one teaspoonful of cream tartar, and

one-half teaspoonful of cream tartar, and one-half teaspoonful of saleratus.

BERRY BREAKFAST CAKE.—One quart of flour, one pint of sour milk, one half cup of butter, one even cup of sugar, three eggs, three cups of berries, one teaspoonful of soda sifted with one-half teaspoonful of salt twice throw the flour. Roll the berries in flour befor ung to the batter. Bake in two shallow pans.

Then nearly fill the dish with apples pared, cored, sliced and slightly stewed with a little sugar and lemon rind. Pour the rest of the batter over, them and bake one hour and a half.

BROWN BREAD. For brown bread take one cup of rye meal, one of Indian meal, one of molasses, two of flour, one pint and a half of sour milk, a teaspoonful of soda, an egg, a teaspoonful of salt. Mix dry ingredients, dissolve the soda in two tablespoonfuls of balling water, add it and the milk to the molasses and pour on the other materials. Beat the eggs and add it. Mix well and steam in a two-quart tin-pan, covered tight; then take the cover off and bake in the oven half an hour. half an hour.


