R Quininæ sulph..... gr. ij. Pulv. digitalis gr. j.

M. Et ft. pil. No. i. Sig.: Every four hours. (In pleuro-pneumonia.)

—Da Costa.

M. Sig.: Teaspoonful three times a day, with blisters over the apex. (In catarrhal pneumonia.)—Da Costa.

R Ammon. carbonat.... gr. xl. Infus. serpentariæ.... f 3 iv.

M. Sig.: Teaspoonful every three hours. (As a stimulant about the crisis.)—Bartholow.

B. Ex. veratri viridis fl... f 3 j.

Sig.: Four to six minims every hour until the pulse falls to sixty-five or seventy.—Stroud.


