


rooms, are covered with canvas and painted. All executive offices, including the rooms of the heads of the departments, have private toilet facilities.

As manufacturers of general electrical appliances, it is natural to expect that the electrical and service installation would be modern and complete. Semi-direct lighting is employed in most of the general offices, and total indirect in the draughting room. An autophone system connects the President's room with all general and executive offices. This is supplemented by a buzzer installation connecting executive with communicating departments. All interworks telephones and outtelephones are controlled by the main switchboard on the ground floor. There is also a master clock in the telephone operators' room with a system of auxiliary clocks in all corridors and executive offices. All buzzer system wires are so arranged that they are completely hidden beneath the main chair rail, which is in sections and can easily be removed so that
