In addition to his political, business and law experience, Prime Minister Mulroney has been involved in community volunteer organizations for many years. He has supported and raised funds for may worthwhile community causes including the United Way of Greater Montreal, the Big Brothers Association of Canada, the Quebec Association for the Mentally Retarded, the Canadian Juvenile Diabetes Foundation and the Montreal Heart Fund, among others.

Brian Mulroney has served on the Boards of Directors of several Canadian universities and devoted considerable energy to fundraising for educational institutions.

For Prime Minister Mulroney, the voluntary sector plays an important role in bringing people together to resolve difficult social and economic problems, both at home and abroad.

Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II came to Canada during the autumn of 1984 to mark bicentennial celebrations in New Brunswick and Ontario, and to visit the province of Manitoba.
