Primary wholesaling and processing operations throughout the United States handled New England fishery products with an estimated initial value of \$1,016 million. The mark-up occurring as a result of these activities averaged 122 percent. The wholesale value of shipments of New England products from processing plants and wholesale markets totaled an estimated \$1,242 million. Of this total, only \$16 million worth of products was exported. After deducting these unprocessed exports and incorporating processed imports worth \$810 million, the value of New England products leaving wholesale markets was estimated at \$3,127 million.
