

- 2:45 p.m. The Royal Couple will leave for the Citadel where they will be greeted by Governor General Vanier, Colonel of the Royal 22nd Regiment and Mme Vanier. The military ceremonies within the Citadel commemorating the 50th anniversary of the Regiment will follow from 3:00-4:00 p.m. For details of the ceremonies, see main *Arrangements* booklet.
- (In addition to bleachers for 2,500 invited guests, separate bleachers have been erected for the writing press, for the CBC, for radio commentators, and for photographers. Their locations will be indicated at previous briefings in the Press Room. The Press buses will leave the Chateau at 2:15 p.m. for arrival at the Citadel at 2:30 p.m.)
- 4:00 p.m. The Queen and Prince Philip will retire to the Citadel residence of the Governor General, and Her Majesty, as Colonel-in-Chief of the Regiment, will receive its officers and their wives.
- 5:30 p.m. The Royal Couple will leave the Citadel for H.M.Y. *Britannia* at Anse-au-Foulon.
- 6:00 p.m. Reception for the Press, Terrace Room, Château Frontenac.
- 8:00 p.m. Her Majesty and His Royal Highness will leave their yacht for the State Dinner offered by the Premier and Mme Lesage at the Château Frontenac.
- (Arrival and presentations may be covered, and a photographic pool will be able to take shots of the Head Table immediately after seating.)
- 10:30 p.m. Her Majesty and His Royal Highness leave the Château Frontenac for H.M.Y. *Britannia*.
