

employees, agents or subcontractors in respect of such vehicles, goods and materials.

4. Dahomey, Upper Volta, Mali, Niger and Senegal shall allow the Canadian contractors, their employees, agents and subcontractors access, without charge, expense or compensation, to any part of their respective territories to which they are required to go for the execution of the project, and, where necessary, shall supply free of charge the services of competent guides.

5. It is acknowledged that the nationals of any of the participating countries whose services have been retained by their governments, the local contractors or the Canadian contractors and their subcontractors in respect of any portion of the project may have to travel frequently between the countries in the course of their work. Dahomey, Upper Volta, Mali, Niger and Senegal agree to facilitate the free movement of such people between their territories.

6. The Post Office and Telecommunications authorities in each participating African country shall prepare, with the assistance of the Canadian consulting engineers, a yearly estimate of the amounts required to enable their government to assume, during the next fiscal year, the obligations contained in this Agreement and its schedules.
