To start Windows NT:

- 1. Turn on your computer.
- 2. When the Begin Logon message appears, press CTRL+ALT+DELETE
- 3. If required, in the Logon Information dialog box, in the User name text box, type your user name.
- 4. In the Password text box, type your password.
- 5. Choose OK.
- 6. If the Welcome screen appears, deselect the *Show this Welcome screen next time you start Windows NT* check box, and then choose Close.

To move the mouse:

- 1. Place the mouse on a flat surface.
- 2. Hold the mouse comfortably with your fingertips resting on the mouse buttons.

3. Slide the mouse in the appropriate direction.

To select an icon with the mouse:

- 1. Point to the icon with the mouse pointer.
- 2. Click the left mouse button.

To move an icon on the desktop:

- 1. Point to the icon you want to move.
- 2. Drag the icon to a new position.

To open the Start menu:

1. Click the Start button.

To close the Start menu:

1. Click the Start button.

To activate a shortcut menu:

- 1. Point to the object you want to use.
- 2. Right-click the mouse.
