Summary

The document begins with a 41 page collection of daily communiqués from the Summit. It also includes the opening speech by José Ramos Horta (Visiting Professor at the University of New South Wales and Special Representative of the National Council of Maubere Resistance) which touches on the following points: continuing need to fulfill human rights commitments, the immorality of arms sales as a cause of destruction and war, and the human rights situations in Burma, China, Taiwan, Tibet, and East Timor. The speech by Maude Barlow (Council of Canadians) is also included, which criticizes APEC as a flawed and misguided process focusing on market-centred ideologies.
