Our uncertainty in this experience may warn us for the future,

let me say in conclusion that whilst the league is not the success it could have been, I telieve we can be satisfied that good work has been done, and although it falls far short of our original hopes, we may be reasonably satisfied with what has been accomplished and only impatient because of what has not been done.

There followed a general discussion of the work of the league and other matters related to heal th conditions in Montreal. The chairman advised the meeting that the necessary money will be raised to make the survey.

It was duly moved, seconded and unanimously carried that a Health Survey of Montreal be made along the lines recommended in the managing director's report and that the chairman beauthorised to select the committee who will be asked to spensor this survey.

It was duly moved, seconded and carried that the report of the managing director he adopted, that the recommendations contained therein be approved and accepted, and that the necessary steps be taken to carry them out.

It was decided that no publicity be given the report of the managing director, nor to the proceedings of the meeting, it being felt that this should be left until the survey committee had been actually formed.

The meeting then adjourned.
