

of his name from the books and imposing a fine of 2s. 6d. for the first offence, may, at their option, reinstate him on the same evening, if two-thirds of the members present are in favor thereof, (the offending individual paying the 2s. 6d. fine and re-signing the Constitution.) For the second like offence, to be reinstated by ballot, and paying the Initiation Fee of 5s.

No. 20.—No subject of a sectarian or political nature shall be introduced before this Encampment.

No. 21.—It shall be the imperative duty of the Kt. Rt. to enforce the penalties of the Constitution, General By-Laws, and By-Laws, upon any and every Knight and Companion who renders himself liable thereto, unless excused by a majority vote of the Encampment.

No. 22.—Amendments or alterations of these By-Laws must be proposed and the merits thereof discussed in open Encampment, and no alteration or addition shall be made without the concurrence of two-thirds of the Companions present; nor unless two weeks notice shall have been first given in writing to the Encampment of the proposed alteration or addition.
