49. No brother shall obtain a Grand Lodge certificate, if he shall have been admitted to more than one degree of masonry on the same day, after the passing and notification of this law.

50. ALL applications for Grand Lodge certificates must be made direct to the grand secretary; and if the name of the brother, wishing for the certificate, has not been previously registered, the money payable on registration must be transmitted at the same time, as no certificate can, on any account be issued until such be paid.

51. WHEN a Lodge certificate is in regular form produced to the grand secretary, he is authorised to issue a certificate from the Grand Lodge, without which no travelling brethren will be entitled to relief, either in Great Britain or foreign parts.

Tyler.

52. The tylers are to be chosen by the members of the Lodge, and may at any time be removed for cause deemed sufficient by a majority of the brethren present, at a regular meeting of the Lodge.

Appeal to

53. As the Grand Lodge, when congregated is a representation of every individual member of the fraternity, it necessarily possesses a supreme superintending authority, and the power of finally deciding on
