CHICAGO GOSSIP.

Henry A. King & Co. 12 King-street east, received the following despatch to-day from Chicago:
The market puzzled the talent to-day. The enormous selling by the principal local speculative holders in the face of an advancing market did not have its expected effect. The announcement that the bull leaders had turned apparently did not materially change the situation. The market had broadened out beyond individual influences and has ceased to be under the control of local operators. Foreign buying and foreign necessities continue to furnish the inspiration to price-makers. The crop expert, told us last Thursday that his careful study of the situation did not warrant him in believing that this country would produce over 400,000,000 bushels of wheat this year. He stated that interior millers were buying more cash wheat than at any time during the past four years, and that they were selling their product for months ahead. There is a question as to whether or not foreign stores and America holds the key to the situation. The news from southeastern districts last week was uniformly bullish and optimistic for export have been heavy and continuous. The feature of the speculative situation is a question of whether or not higher prices, but we believe in the 70c wheat.

Corn and Oats--The increase in Western freight rates, to take effect Nov. 1, did not have much effect on prices, although it was undoubtedly a heavy weight in this month. This market sympathizes with wheat to a large extent, and there was considerable increase in the volume of speculation. The large short interest has been evidence during past months in support of the view that the market is in a speculative position.
