

No. 4—Another method calls for application of some agent such as gasoline or cedar oil, sprayed into the cracks and crevices of the bed, wall, baseboards, etc.

No. 5—A reader wrote a short time ago that she found this mixture efficacious in destroying buffalo moths, and if the same process were followed it should destroy bedbugs as well:

"Take four ounces of coal oil, four ounces of turpentine and add about three tablespoons of cayenne pepper; apply with a small bunch of feathers or brush to the cracks and edges of the floor and on top of the carpet edges every couple of weeks for a while.
