

energy. Your Committee feel assured that every Churchman in the Diocese will heartily join with them in gratitude to the venerable S. P. G. for the great kindness it has shown us in past time, and for the support which it still continues to give to our missions, and will offer their prayers that the efforts of that Society, now more especially directed to Heathen countries, may be crowned with success and blessing.

Although the collections for other Church purposes have tended to lessen our receipts, yet the total amount received during 1863 is about \$1000 more than in the year 1862. The income for general purposes is however \$50 less; owing to the fact that a larger amount than usual has been reserved by the Parishes for special purposes.

The Committee have been enabled somewhat to enlarge their Missionary grants, yet they wish every member of the Church distinctly to understand that to meet the increased and daily increasing wants of the Church in Nova Scotia, the income of this Society must be annually enlarged.

The Executive Committee cannot but feel that no more effective mode can be adopted for the support of the Church in this Diocese than a regular and steady increase in the general funds of the D. C. S.
