Report of Committee on Modes of Work:

1. The Committee on Modes of Work consider that, as the distribution of the literature of the Woman's Missionary Society has proved so beneficial in arousing interest in its work, it would be well if a lady were appointed in each Auxiliary to distribute leaflets and try to secure new members.

2. They recommend that, where practicable, missionary "At-Homes" be held, the entertainment to be of a decidedly missionary character, and that it be understood that money is not so much the object of these gatherings as to quicken interest in mission work.

3. They also recommend that each Auxiliary, by its President or Corresponding Secretary, confer with the pastors of their respective churches, and ask that one of the ordinary prayer-meetings once a month be made a missionary prayer-meeting.

The Financial Report was submitted by Mrs. Wilson. This showed a net income of \$615.50, an increase of \$56.54 over last year.
