We have pleasure in reporting continued satisfaction in our work in the Central Prison Sabbath School. Therefore, services have been, without interruption, carried on throughout the year, and, as in former years, the teachers have felt much encouraged to continue their labors.

There is but little, if any, change in the numbers attending the services, as compared with other years. During the winter the number is considerably larger than during the summer, but the average for the whole year is about 175. The average attendance of teachers during the winter is 26, and during the summer 18. What can be done by the Prison Officers to aid us in our work is done, and we very gratefully record our thanks to them.
