Petrograd, March 15-(Via London)-The Turks are in retreat on the Caucasian front, pursued by the Russians, the war office announces. Kermanshah has been captured. The announcement follows "In the direction of Sakkiz our troops, pressing the retreating Turks,

are approaching toward Banu. In the direction of Hamadan, after an obstinate battle lasting two days, our troops took possession of the town of Kermannah. Pursuit of the Turks continues."


