ROUND-THE-WORLD FLIGHT PROPOSED

(Canadian Press Despatch.) San Francisco, Dec. 10.—Sir Keith Smith, famous British aviator, has arrived here to prepare for a round-the-world flight he proposes to make in the spring of 1923.

The course of the air cruise will leave from London to Egypt and Mesopotamia over India and Burma to the China Coast and across Japan; thence to the Aleutian Islands, Alaska, and Vancouver, across Canada to New York, up to St. John's, Nfld., and finally to London by Greenland and Iceland.

Sir Keith expects to complete the entire journey in 800 flying hours over a period of three months.

WHAT ONE NATION DID.
