Rev. Dr. Sullivan, by permission of the House, withdrew the following motion, of which he had given notice:—

That the first clause of that article of the Constitution which refers to the Executive Committee, be amended by the insertion of the words "the four Rural Deans" after the word "Treasurer," and the substitution of the word "eleven" for "fifteen" clerical members.

Archdeacon Lindsay moved, seconded by Mr. Thomas:

That a committee be appointed by the Bishop to prepare rules and regulations regarding the sale or change of any property belonging to the diocese, or to any parish or mission.—Carried.

Rev. F. H. CLAYTON moved, seconded by Rev. H. W.

That this Synod shall meet once in two years instead of annually, as at present.

This motion was withdrawn,

The Rev. Dr. SULLIVAN proposing, seconded by Rev. F. H. CLAYTON:

That a committee be appointed to whom shall be referred the question of a change from an annual to a biennial meeting of the Synod of this diocese, said committee to report at next Synod.—Carried.

The meeting adjourned till half-past two o'clock.
