

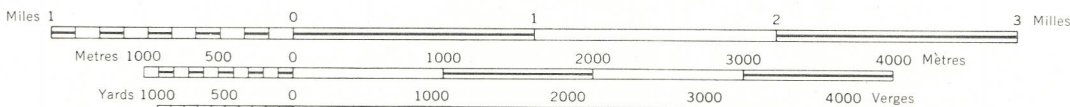

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES

EXAMPLE: HOUSE

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	75
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northeast to point	7
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point	757
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northeast to point	7
MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	757784

Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
