Dear Sir .-

We are today in receipt of the Grant from your Department to The Imperial Oil Company, Limited, of portions of Tecumseh and Park Streets and of the lane between Lots 5 to 9 inclusive, Range V, and Lots 5 to 9 inclusive, Range VI, I looked over your description and I fear that the draftsman has mistaken the dimensions of Block 49. You will nxotice that the description by metes and bounds reads "Commencing at the South West corner of Block No. 49." According to the Registry Office 49 is not a Block but a lot which has its Westerly boundary at the water's edge of the River St. Clair and extends back from that from 2000 to 3000 feet. The description by metes and bounds also mentions Block 50. This also is Lot 50 which commences at the water's edge and extends back from 2000 to 3000 feet. These are the lots which were ceded by the Indians and the Indian Department to the Town of Sarnia and are lots similar in frontage and depth to the present Lots 44, 43, etc., in the present Indian Reserve which is immediately
