to the work both by residents of the locality and friends in the city has been gratifying to the Committee. Very substantial assistance has been given by the ladies of the congregation who conducted a most successful Bazaar in February last, and members and adherents have responded cheerfully, while members of city churches also have given liberal contributions to the Building Fund, and towards the cost of the organ.

The success which has thus far attended the establishing of the church is evidence of it being a much needed work—the outward tabernacle having now been set up in our midst, let us pray that the Holy Spirit may be established in our hearts.
