

**Proviso.** or usage or custom to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding; Provided always, that nothing in this Act shall extend to make valid any marriage illegally solemnized, when the parties to any such illegal marriage, or either of them, have subsequently contracted matrimony with any other person according to law. 5

**Marriages under certain repealed Acts to be valid notwithstanding repeal.** II. Notwithstanding the repeal of any Act or Acts by the said Act passed in the twentieth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, chaptered sixty-six, whereby any marriages were legalized or declared to have been legal, the said marriages are hereby declared to have been and to continue to be legal to all intents and purposes as if the said Act or 10 Acts had not been repealed.
