An Act to amend the Weights and Measures Act as respects the contents of Packages of Salt.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

 Section 1 of chapter 25 of the statutes of 1888, initial 1888, c. 25. An Act to amend the Weights and Measures Act as respects the 5 contents of packages of salt, is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—

"1. Every barrel of salt packed in bulk, sold or offered for Contents of sale, shall contain two hundred and eighty pounds of salt, and marking of every such barrel or sack of salt, sold or offered for sale, shall barrels and barrels and sacks.

10 have the correct gross weight thereof, and in the case of a barrel sucks. the net weight also, marked upon it in a plain and permanent manner."

2. Section 3 of the said Act is repealed and the following is New section 3. substituted therefor :---

15 "3. The name or the registered trade mark of the packer of Name to be the salt, if it is packed in Canada, or the name and address of marked on the importer, if it is packed elsewhere than in Canada, shall be marked, stamped or branded on every barrel or sack of salt sold or offered for sale in Canada."
