fore procured, and a sum of money has been raised under and by virtue of an Act of the General Assembly of this Island, intituled An Act for preventing accidents by Fire, and for appointing Fire-Wards in Charlotte-Town, and the Suburbs thereof.

Be it enacted, That the Assessors to be appointed under and by virtue of this Act, shall have the power, Assessors to collect and sue for and they are hereby required, to demand, sue for, col- all monies that also all such of the Buckets, Implements and Materials, as shall have been furnished in pursuance thereof, and keep the same for the purposes in this Act mentioned.

XX. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force, for and during the space of in force for three three years, and from thence to the end of the then years. next Session of the General Assembly and no longer.

CAP. VII.

An Act for continuing an Act of the General Assembly, made and passed in the Forty-seventh year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for the purpose of defraying Contingent Expenses of the General Assembly of this Island.
