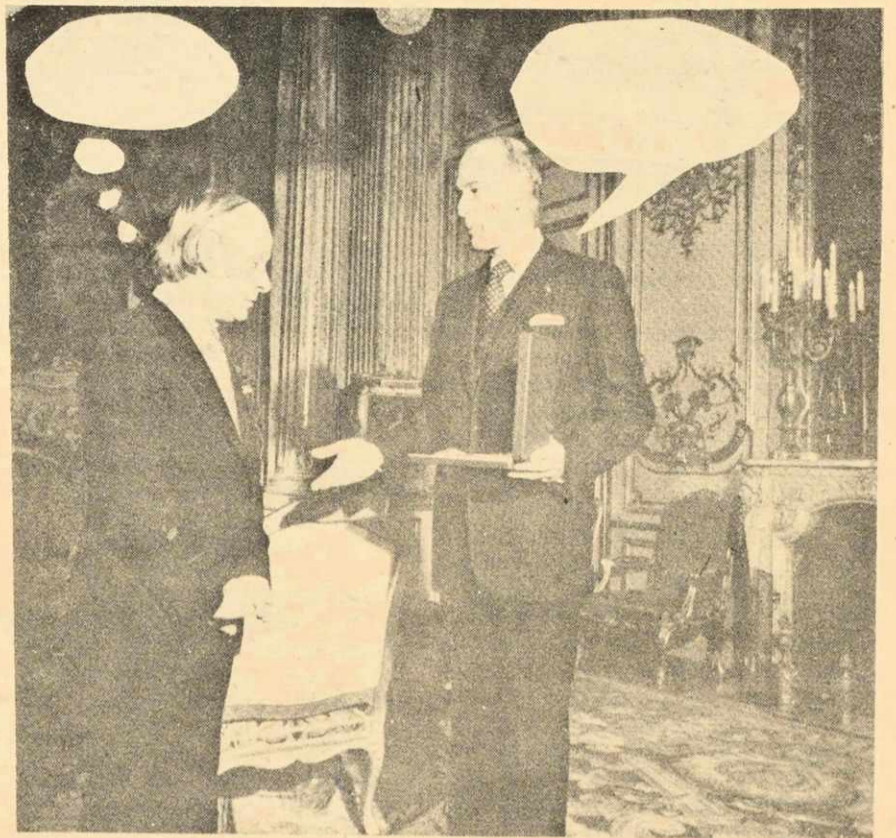


Silly Snaps
