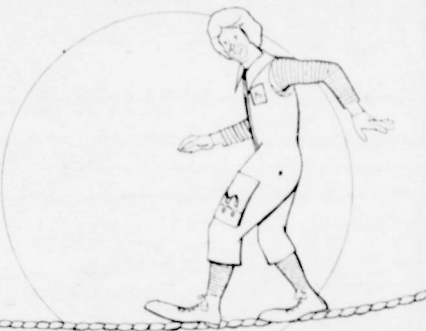

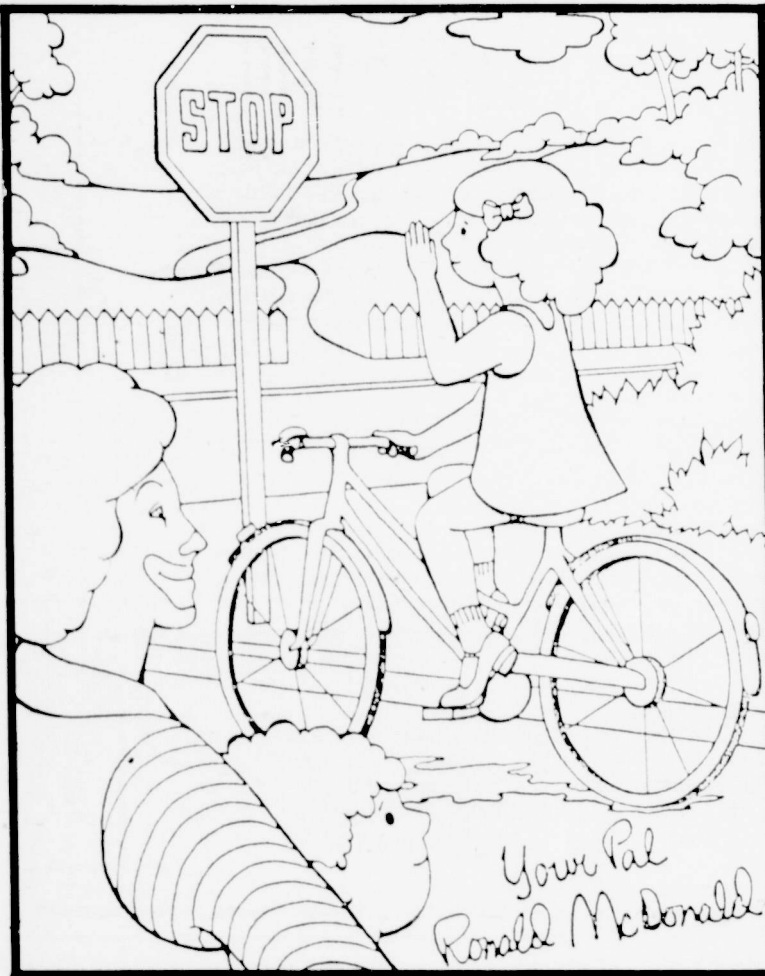


### Bicycle Safety

- be on the lookout at all times

- your bicycle should have a back light or reflector
- don't ride after dark unless your bike has lights
- must obey all signs and traffic lights
- be careful when passing parked cars
- most important is to learn the rules of the road
