Re liquor in possession of parties on Highway running through Indian Reserves in Manitoba and parties having liquor in their possession on Lands Patented to them within the Reserves

In my opinion persons having liquor in their possession on a Highway running through an Indian Reserve may be proceeded against under Section 91 of the Indian Act of 1869 as amended by 44 Victoria Chapter 17 Section 11 - with respect to parties having liquor in their possession on lands patented to them within the Reserves it is not stated how, or under what authority the Patents to these lands were obtained, and therefore I must give an opinion upon that point without further information
