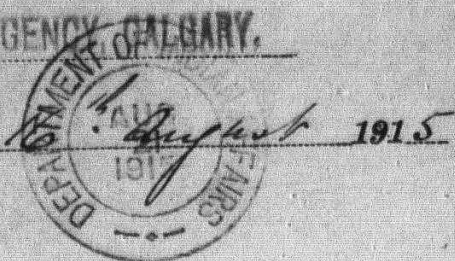
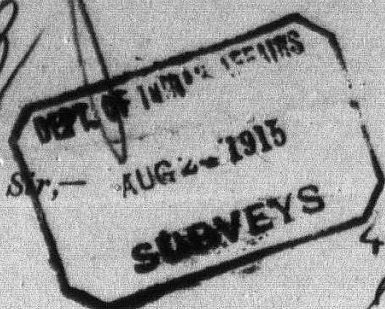

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 6th Aug 1915 No 219547 enclosing a blue print plan showing the road colored red thereon which the Provincial Government desires to open up as a highway.

I would state this matter was brought up before the Chief and Members of the Sarcee Band some time ago, and they were agreeable to allow this road to be made without compensation, it will give us two pasture fields instead of one, and allow us to divide cattle when required. Two gates will be required across the lane communicating with the two fields.

On account of so much water in Bay Meadows we have only just starting haying and I don't want to lose any time bringing Indians from their work. 12 miles from Glenora I will therefore get their consent in writing in about 3 weeks - you may however consider the matter as granted.
