

there has been no recent inquiry into working-class family budgets.

In view of the above, it is quite apparent that the methods of compiling cost of living statistics are due for early revision and improvement. We express the hope that we may have the co-operation of the Department of Labour in effecting necessary revision.

In conclusion, we desire to again assure the Government that in its consideration of these and other measures for human betterment and national well-being the experience of our Joint Legislative Committee is at your service.
