

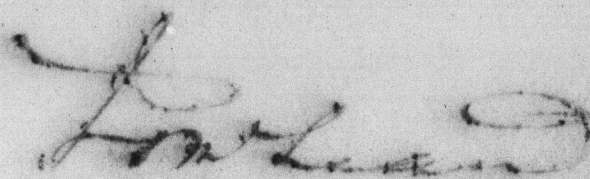
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Ottawa, 19th February, 1912.

Sir:-

I beg to transmit herewith a copy of letter which the Department has received from Mr. Borthwick, in which he suggests that a young Indian of his Agency, Isidore Ledoux, be allowed to go to Regina to attend a School of Instruction, with a view of obtaining a certificate to enable him to operate an engine. The Department views the suggestion favourably, and has agreed to allow Ledoux to obtain the course prescribed by the school. The Department will be glad to have an expression of your view as to whether it would be advisable to appoint the young man to operate the oil-pull at the Piegan Agency, provided he obtains the necessary certificate.
