I also transmit the account of \$56.00 which you embatted from Mr. Constantin, Inthis case also the Repertment will make payment at a per dies rate, but will not allow allege charges as the Boster travelled on the reilroad. Only reilway fore will be allowed him with book for the period that he was absent from Heet-quarters.
