

Ottawa, 9th November, 1912.

Sir:-

I enclose herewith an account rendered at \$32.00, which you forwarded on the 2nd instant from Dr. J. Constantin in connection with a trip which he made to Kiskisink to vaccinate Indians. The Department will allow the Doctor railway fare and board and pay him at a per diem rate. He should furnish a statement giving the names of the Indians vaccinated. A supply of medical account forms is transmitted herewith upon which the Doctor should make out his account.

I also transmit the account of \$54.00 which you submitted from Dr. Constantin. In this case also the Department will make payment at a per diem rate, but will not allow mileage charges as the Doctor travelled on the railroad. Only railway fare will be allowed him with board for the period that he was absent from ^{his} Headquarters.
