

On Saturday, 1st Jan 44, the accused, whom I now recognize, came to the Officers' Mess and asked for recreational transport. I refused this request, and on 1 Jan 44 he was not authorized to use any vehicle on charge to this unit. The Duty Truck, when not in use, is usually parked just outside the Administration Building, No.1 Sub-Depot, 1 C.B.O.D.

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.
