Dear Sirs:

I would refer to your occupation of Indian Reserve No. 4, Koo Too Wis, Indian River, on the west coast of Vancouver Island and would advise that this matter is being held up pending a complete setting out of your requirements on the Reserve.

You may no doubt recollect that Mr. T.H. Simpson, Inspector of the Canadian National Railways Land Department objected on the 15th ultimo to payment of a rental of \$35.00 per month to the Band for use of certain lands. I was informed by him that there would be other easements, etc., needed on the Reserve and when these requirements had been determined the question of rental for the entire application could be dealt with.
