

Our Returned Heroes

On Thursday last Private James Pearl returned to his home in Kentville after a period of service for his King and country. He landed at Montreal and immediately came to his home. He is a son of Mr. John Pearl and has been absent about three years leaving here with the 112th. Batt. He has seen much severe fighting, has been buried by Hun shells and was seriously wounded last March and in hospital since that time. He returns with a whole body but his health is shattered generally and he leaves soon for Halifax, for further treatment. It is expected that after the shock of war is over that he will probably regain his full strength.

Owen Sanford

Owen Sanford is another of our men who was fortunate enough to escape fatality at the hands of the enemy and on Wednesday last he returned to his home and family at Kentville.

Mr. Sanford enlisted with the 112th, was absent two years and had two slight flesh wounds besides a shell shock which disabled him. He has received a hearty welcome home by a wife and large family and numerous friends.

He enlisted with the 85th Battalion July 23rd, 1915 and drilled at Halifax and Aldershot, going Overseas Oct. 9th, 1916. He had been wounded once and entirely recovered. He again left England for France and on Sept. 3rd, 1918 while fighting for his King and Native Land was killed. He leaves a wife and four small children also a father, mother, four sisters, and five brothers to mourn their great loss.
