THREE MEN HURT AT ROSSING MILL

Collapse of Stage Hurls Five to the Ground and all but Two are Badly Shaken up

A serious accident happened at the Rossing mill at Morrison Cove yesterday afternoon when a new roof was being put on the fire house. Five men of Douglastown were on the staging raising ringbeams when suddenly the platform collapsed, hurling all five to the ground.

Robert Simpson was struck on the breast by the falling iron and was badly hurt, John Taylor had his collar bone broken and his arm hurt. James Simpson was hurt in the back and side McCosh and Joseph Young escaped without injury.

The falling of the stage is attributed to a defected piece of lumber.

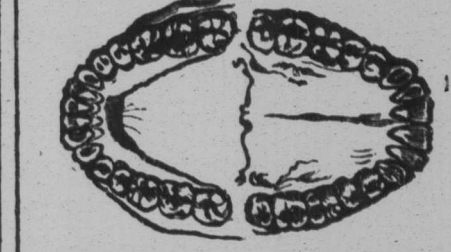
