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A MIDNIGHT MASS.

Rev. Henry M. Field, a Protestant minister, gives the following description of the wonders of the Cathedral of Seville:

It was eleven o'clock when we went up the broad steps, and found ourselves in the interior of one of the greatest temples in Christendom. It was not merely its vast size which impressed us (although it is over four hundred feet long, and nearly three hundred feet wide), but the perfect proportion of the whole that gave it an air of majesty, which is perhaps the truest test of what is great in architecture. The height is in proportion to the length and breadth, the nave rising to a hundred and fifty feet, while the dome is still higher. How enormous must be the columns which support such a roof and such a weight! Although massive as the weight resting on them requires, yet they are of such height that a perfect symmetry is preserved, as in some stately trees which combine great strength, striking down deep into the earth, and yet soaring to the sky. 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
