

of each season at very low rates. In fact, strawberries have been the cheapest fruit on the market. Possibly the recent low prices have had the effect of discourag-ing growers from planting new fields, and quite likely the price of berries will be bigher. higher. If the plauta are set out the last of April or the first of May they will commence to grow immediately. The cultivation is very simple. It consists in keeping the ground entirely free from grass and weeds by the use of a sharp hoe. In July and Angust runners will appear, and as they do they should be cut or pinched off while they are tender and before they exhaust the strength of the plants.
