

## MEMBERS OF THE SIFTON CABINET

**PREMIER SIFTON.**  
Hon. Arthur Lewis Sifton, late chief justice of Alberta, who has left the bench to return to active political life, is the eldest son of Hon. J. W. Sifton, of Winnipeg, who, many years ago, had the honor of being speaker of the Manitoba legislature. Hon. A. L. Sifton was born near London, Ont., on October 26, 1856. He received his early education at the schools there. In 1875 the family moved to Manitoba and in the following year he was sent back to Ontario to enter Victoria university at Coburg. He graduated there in 1880 with the degree of B.A. The degrees of M.A. and LL.B. were conferred upon him in 1883 by his alma mater. After his graduation he studied law in Winnipeg, and was called to the bar of Manitoba, first practicing his profession in Brandon. His active mind and interest in public affairs displayed itself at an early date, and when the first council of Brandon was elected in 1882 the very youthful lawyer was one of the aldermen.

**HON. C. R. MITCHELL.**  
Charles Richmond Mitchell, a son of the late James Mitchell, inspector of lighthouses for the province of New Brunswick, was born at Newcastle, N. B., on November 29th, 1872. He received his education at the academy, Newcastle, and the University of New Brunswick at Fredericton, N. B., graduating from the latter institution with the degree of B.A. in 1894. He shortly afterwards commenced the study of law in the office of the late Hon. Andrew G. Blair, at the same time minister of railway in the Laurier cabinet, at St. John. In 1897 the degree of B.C.L. was conferred upon him by King's college, Windsor, N.S.

He has always been closely allied with the Liberal party in Alberta, and last fall was chosen a member of the Rutherford cabinet. He owns an 800-acre farm at Olds, and to it has given the experience of his early life on the old homestead in Ontario.

**HON. DUNCAN MARSHALL.**  
Hon. Duncan Marshall was born Sept. 24th, 1872, in the township of Ellerslie, County Bruce, Ont. He is a son of the late John Marshall, one of the hardy Scotch pioneers of the district who did so much in the early days to make the Ontario of the present. He was educated at the public and high schools of his native place, and later matriculated from Owen Sound Collegiate institute with a teacher's certificate.

**HON. A. J. McLEAN.**  
Hon. A. J. McLean, while not a prominent member of the Legislature in last session, the first in which he was in the House, is recognized as one of the ablest members from the south. He has been one of the largest individual ranchers and mine owners of the south, and has extensive coal interests around Lethbridge and in the Crow's Nest. A business man of considerable ability he will bring to the cabinet the same business acumen that has made him successful in commercial affairs.

**Against School Privileges Granted to French Speaking Catholics.**

As soon as a few French Canadians are located together in a township they ask for a priest of their own and a school of their own, and if they cannot get the latter they ask that one of the teachers be a French Canadian.

**IGNORES MOTHER FOR FORTUNE**  
Chicago, June 2.—Leslie Dudley Carter, jr., has abandoned his suit started with the view of breaking his father's will, and court developments in the case indicate that the young man will abide by the terms of the will which demanded that he sever all relations of a friendly character with his mother or be disinherited. Carter, sr., and his actress wife, who is now Mrs. Leslie Carter-Payne, had been estranged some time before Carter's death. In his will he mentioned their estrangement in bitter terms. The estate is valued at about \$750,000. This was a surprise to Carter's friends, as it was believed his estate aggregated a million dollars.

**BYE ELECTIONS**

**BEFORE PRIVY COUNCIL—FORMER DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL REPRESENTS PROVINCE.**

## GRAIN GROWERS WANT PROVINCIAL ELEVATORS

**Saskatchewan Commission Heard Representatives Yesterday at Wapella—Suggestions Tendered.**  
Wapella, Sask., May 31.—The elevator commission met at 9:30 this morning and at once proceeded with the examination of Mr. Selmon, representing the Kelso branch of the Grain Growers' Association, of which he is president. He asked for a system of provincial elevators, so that the identity of a farmer's grain would be preserved till it reached the buyer. It was advisable to have purely national elevators to weigh and ship only, the farmers to provide for such elevators and give security. He would be willing to pay a tax of one cent a bushel on all grain to meet the cost.

**BIG SALE OF SCHOOL LANDS AT MEDICINE HAT**  
Prices Range Much Higher Than Expected—\$122 an Acre as the Average Though Some Brought as High as Thirty Dollars—Southern Alberta Land Company Big Purchaser.

Seventeen laborers are missing, and it is believed all were killed. Those missing include Hugh McGuire, the foreman, seven Italians, seven Hungarians and two Japanese.
